



South Morang Football Netball Club Risk Management Policy

1. Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to provide a framework for the elimination or control of all risks associated with the South Morang Football Netball Club's activities.

Risks are inherent in all aspects of Australian Rules Football and the South Morang Football Netball Club acknowledges the role of risk management as critical to the safe and controlled provision of the sport to players, officials and spectators.

2. Scope

The Club needs to be prepared to deal with:

- Public & Professional Liability responsibilities.
- Occupational Health & Safety responsibilities.
- Financial Management.
- Organisational Management and Operational practices.

The South Morang Football Netball Club is committed to managing risk in accordance with the process described in Australian/New Zealand Standard 4360:1999 Risk Management, as well as the club's established ethical standards and values.

The objectives of the policy are:

- Encourage the ongoing identification and reporting of potential risks.
- Analyse the Club's liability associated with any identified risks.
- Develop, prioritise and implement ongoing plans and strategies to address risks.
- Minimise the cost of insurance claims and premiums.
- Protect the club's corporate image as a professional, responsible and ethical organisation.

3. Policy Review

This policy will be reviewed annually to ensure it remains relevant to club operations and reflects both community expectations and legal requirements.
